Infectious Disease Nurse - Division of Prevention and Wellness

- Continuous Posting -

The Infectious Disease Nurse will perform surveillance for local health departments through investigation, analysis of data, and partnerships with other health professionals.

Duties Include:

- Collaborate with staff, hospitals, infection control preventionists, physicians, schools, ODH and others to provide a comprehensive approach to surveillance and follow-up
- Investigate epidemic situations of infectious diseases through field visits, surveys, other epidemiological methods
- Collect data for surveillance in the community by abstracting data from confidential medical or public health records, through survey, other approaches
- Ensure data management for investigations by using appropriate statistical techniques
- Disseminate pertinent information to agencies using various marketing strategies (e.g., newsletter, fact sheets, lectures, etc.)
- Assist in the enforcement of regulations for reportable infectious diseases
- Provide vaccinations to the public and other related duties as assigned.

Requirements:

Must be a Registered Nurse with the State of Ohio and current CPR certification. Bachelor's Degree from an accredited College of Nursing (Master's Degree preferred); at least one (1) year of nursing experience with focus in infectious disease or public health, one (1) year experience analyzing statistical information. Must possess a valid driver's license, and be insurable through FCPH's provider. Some evening and weekend hours required.

Salary Range: \$23.29/hourly - \$29.11/hourly. This is a non-exempt position.
